Budworth Bulletin produces 10 issues each year and is delivered to 275 households in the Great Budworth, Aston-by-Budworth and Arley areas.

Each issue requires the support of 19 volunteers to distribute and deliver the Bulletins.

The Bulletin includes regular, monthly news from the St. Mary's Church, the Primary School, Women's Institute, Garden and Cricket Clubs, and the Heritage Society, alongside notification of future events, such as concerts, and issues of local interest. It is also a valuable medium through which the Parish Council can communicate with its community, either through reports by the Chairman on PC meetings or through articles dealing with specific issues or areas of interest.

The editors actively encourage people in the area to submit articles in the Bulletin. As a result, we have published items written by residents on such subjects as the Night Sky, Mining Bees in the village, the filming of a BBC serial in the village, local travel and traffic information and awards to local people.

Newcomers to the village are welcomed in the Bulletin, encouraging neighbours to make contact.			
The Budworth Bulletin has been printed in full colour for the last 18 months, a change that has been very well received by our readers. However, printing costs are now three times their former cost. We would obviously like to continue printing in colour and, to that end, hope that the Parish Council will favourably consider our request for a £400 grant.
