Dear Resident,

Colas, working on behalf of Cheshire West & Chester Council, plan to carry out essential gully cleansing works on High Street, Great Budworth.

**When will the works be taking place?**

The gully cleanse will be carried out as follows:

Friday 30th May between 09:00—12:00hrs.

**What will be done?**

The gullies will be cleaned and flushed out.

**What impact will it have on me?**

To enable us to access the drains, all vehicles need to be removed from the High Street on Friday 30th May. This will enable us to carry out the works efficiently and minimise disruption and inconvenience to residents.

Please be advised that any vehicle hindering or obstructing our operations will be removed.

**What precautions should I take?**

If you are unable to move your vehicle due to holidays or sickness, please ensure it is not parked over a drain. Any vehicle obstructing our work will need to be moved to the nearest convenient place, as per the granted permissions.

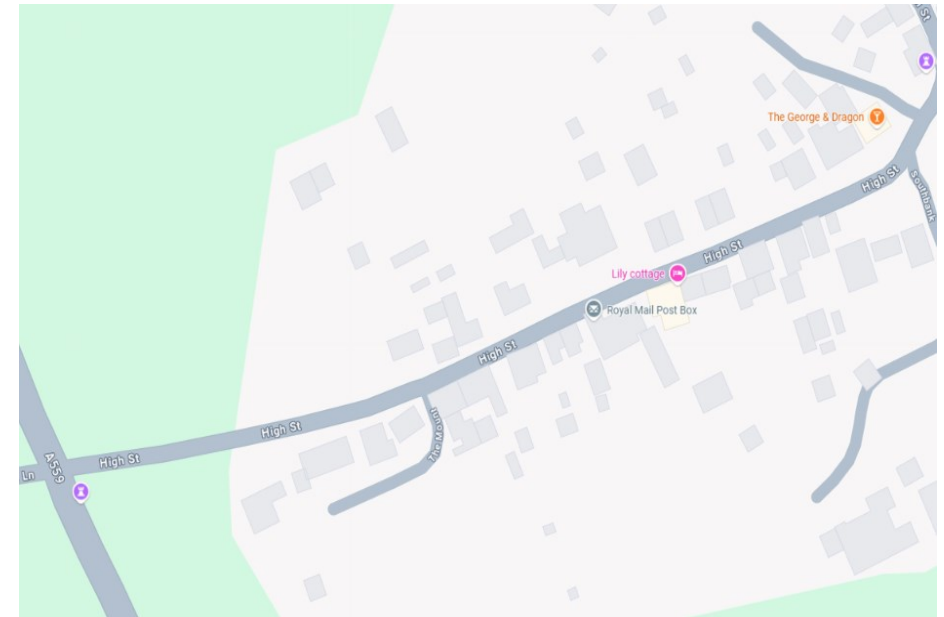
**Frequently asked questions**

**Q. What is a Gully?**

A gully is a drain. We are responsible for clearing the debris from the bottom of the chamber and ensuring the pipe to the mains runs clear.

**Q. Why are you doing this?**

We are contracted by Cheshire West & Chester to maintain the cleanliness of the gullies in the county.



**Q. How long will it take?**

We need to have the road clear of vehicles for the full morning.

**Q. What if I need access for moving house, funerals etc?**

In the event of exceptional circumstances please contact us on the number below and we will inform the works supervisor who will allow access to and from the road.
