Temporary Road Closure

WESTAGE LANE in NORTHWICH

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit traffic on the following length of road in NORTHWICH, to enable gully emptying. Works to be carried out by UE500 - Colas Ltd (CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER COUNCIL).

WESTAGE LANE: Westage lane, great Budworth

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used for the conveyance of persons goods or merchandise to or from any premises situate on or adjacent to the lengths of road or in connection with agriculture building construction works of repair and the like or use in an emergency of vehicles for fire brigade ambulance or police purposes. A through route will not always be available and any vehicles not requiring access to properties on the length of road should use the alternative routes.

The closure will come into force on 05/11/2025 and will continue in force for a maximum of five days. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately 1 days to complete.

Alternative routes for through traffic

Traffic should proceed via:

Westage Lane, great Bduworth 05/11/2025 09:30 to 05/11/2025 15:30

Westage Lane, Budworth Heath Lane, Belmont Road, High Street, Warrington Road, Church Street

Go east on Westage Lane (444.90 metres)

Turn left on Budworth Road (455.92 metres)

Make a sharp left on Budworth Heath Lane (1376.53 metres)

Continue forward on Belmont Road (857.69 metres)

Turn left on A559 (Warrington Road) (730.24 metres)

Turn left on High Street (296.04 metres)

Bear left on Church Street (101.92 metres)

Bear right on Westage Lane (7.42 metres)
